Dear Patient,

You will need to obtain a Preoperative History and Physical exam within 30 days of your surgery date with your Primary Care Provider (PCP). This will insure that you do not have any other issues going on that may supersede your foot surgery. In addition, your PCP will make sure that you can handle the anesthesia without trouble.

Our office does not require anything specific be completed or labs run, unless your PCP deems it necessary for your clearance. FMH requires an ECG and H&H if you are over the age of 60. All Females will have a urine HCG, which is completed at FMH during your preregistration apt. All diabetic patients need a blood glucose.

Tricare Member's you can see any provider on base. However, your notes need to be signed or cosigned by a provider who has privileges at Fairbanks Memorial Hospital (FMH). This shows FMH that a provider is legally a physician with all the qualifications for the state of Alaska, and therefore, has the abilities to clear patients for surgery.

Please make sure your PCPs office faxes their complete H&P to our office so it can be paired with your surgeon's pre-op note and sent to FMH from our office.
